Common Credentials held by RDNs and NDTRs

Registered Dietitian Nutritionists (RDN) and Nutrition and Dietetic Technicians, Registered (NDTR) expand and elevate their individual practice through education and training. This list consists of additional credentials commonly held by RDNs and NDTRs that may or may not be eligible for CPE units. This list is not all-inclusive and the credentials listed are not endorced by CDR. Practitioners should thoroughly evaluate chosen programs to ensure that the education and training provided are appropriate to meet their needs and to determine whether they are eligible. The *Minimum Requirements* column provides only the minimum credential or educational eligibility requirement. Additional experience, education, and/or training may be required.

In this resource, CDR has chosen to use the term RDN to refer to both registered dietitians (RD) and registered dietitian nutritionists (RDN), and to use the term NDTR to refer to both dietetic technician, registered (DTR) and nutrition and dietetics technician, registered (NDTR).
