

Funding

The Commission on Dietetic Registration (CDR) defines funding as revenue generated by the Provider (or affiliated parent or sister companies) from the manufacture, distribution, sale, resale, or promotion of non-CPE business lines, products, services, or commodities, which is utilized in the planning, development, review, and presentation of CPE.¹

Per Policy 10.1 (Documentation of Funding) in the CDR CPEU Prior Approval Program policy manual, the Accountable Contact must produce accurate and written documentation of funding as a component of the annual report.
